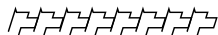

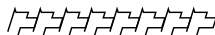

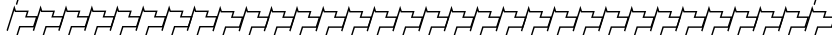

**MOTOR HOME/TRAILER RESERVATION NOTICE
PARKING SPACES WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM
NOON TUESDAY, JANUARY 31, 2012**

Overnight reservations will be available at a fee of \$20.00 per space/per night (a space is 1½ parking spaces). All reservations will be in assigned spaces and only ONE vehicle permitted per space. A tow unit (eg: cube van) and a trailer is considered one vehicle. All units must be self-contained. No water or sewer hookups but limited electric will be available. No waste or grey water is to be discharged onto the ground. RV vehicle and other property must be kept within assigned parking spaces. **NO CONES OR SIMILAR MEANS ALLOWED TO RESERVE SPACES.** If you need additional room please park your vehicle in the designated public parking area or purchase two sites.

Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their space. Anyone who does not leave their space in the same condition as when they arrived will be subject to forfeiture of future parking spaces.

Spaces will be assigned in the order of receipt of their fee and Reservation Application. A confirmation will be sent for each reservation only if a self-addressed stamped envelope is enclosed. This confirmation is the admission ticket to the parking area and must be presented upon arrival at the show grounds. **PARKING SPACE IS LIMITED AND WILL LIKELY NOT BE AVAILABLE ON THE DAY OF THE SHOWS. SHOULD SPACES BE AVAILABLE, THE PARKING FEE IS \$25.00 PER NIGHT/PER SPACE.** If you wish to park next to a particular party, the Reservation Applications must be received in the same envelope.

Overnight reservations are a privilege extended by Union County Kennel Club, Inc., Sand & Sea Kennel Club, Boardwalk Kennel Club, Inc. and the Wildwood Convention Center. EXHIBITOR ENTRANCES - DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE BUILDING THROUGH THE MAIN DOOR.

EXHIBITOR DAY PARKING - All vehicle parking is on hard-top surface. Day Parking is free, **one space per vehicle, for additional space there will be a charge!** All parking is at your own risk. Show-giving clubs assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle, its contents or dogs.

Fire lanes must be kept open at all times and will be under constant surveillance. Unauthorized or illegally parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

Co-operation with all parking personnel including following instructions and directions is required. Failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of your parking privileges on the grounds for the shows.

HANDICAP PARKING - Limited handicap parking will be available only upon proof of valid placard or license. These spaces will provide easy access to the building.

BUILDING ACCESS HOURS - Tuesday, January 31, 2012 at 12:00 Noon. There will be security provided and the building will be locked at 11:00 P.M. and reopened at 6:00 A.M. each morning. Dogs must be removed by 7:00 P.M. Sunday, February 5, 2012.

UNLOADING - Unloading will be allowed only in designated areas. Allow enough time.

***Private Exercise Pens will be publicly used! Beware that any private exercise pens that are setup outside around or on the loading dock they will be publicly used. Private exercise pens are to be kept clean at all times and are the responsibility of the person who set them up. Those private exercise pens that are not kept clean will be asked to remove them! Therefore, private exercise pens are not private.**

CANINE COURTESY

All dogs shall be kept under control at all times! Please **no flexi leads on show grounds or in building.**

You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care inside and outside the building and show areas. **Please exercise dogs in designated areas only.**

All regulations will be enforced by the Grounds Committee.

CRATE & GROOMING AREA

Electrical outlets - First Come, First Served.

Electrical outlets inside building: Any exhibitor opening any unauthorized areas or electrical boxes a fine of \$500.00 will be imposed.

Additional electrical outlets can be provided to exhibitors for an additional fee of \$50.00. Anyone wishing to purchase additional electrical outlets please see club Event Committee personnel.

An area will be provided for crates and grooming. Please stack all your crates and no saving spaces. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the Crate or Grooming Section is prohibited. Soft crates are not permitted.

Crates & Grooming Tables are permitted in designated areas only. **No Crates or Grooming Tables in aisles or ringside.**

Private exercise pens will not be permitted in the building.

Due to the number of crates and grooming tables, chairs will not be permitted in the crate/grooming/handlers' section.

NO PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS OR LARGE RUGS ARE PERMITTED IN THE WILDWOOD CONVENTION CENTER.

All trash and litter must be placed in containers provided.

NO DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE RESTROOMS.

***Disposal of dog elimination & grooming residue (fur, etc.) in the restrooms is PROHIBITED.**

Food for exhibitors & spectators will be available.

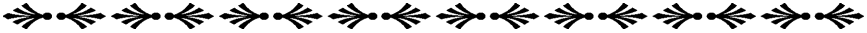

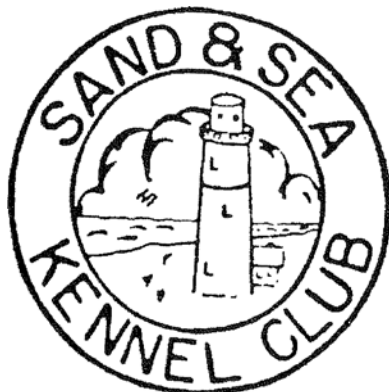

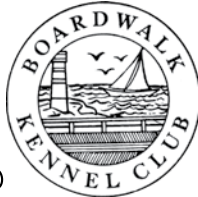

Sanitary conditions will be observed in all show areas and halls including parking areas. Any violation of these regulations will be severely dealt with. Anyone caught disposing of grooming residue or dog eliminations in floor/wall electrical outlets or any inappropriate places will be subject to an Event Committee Hearing.
